

#### Oesophageal Cancer

- Rising Incidence
  - -87% for Men
  - -40% Women
  - UK incidence for Women is highest in Europe

- Smoking
- Sedentary lifestyle
- Heredity
- Ethnicity
- Diet
- Obesity
- GORD
- Barrett's Oesophagus

- Alcohol
- Hpylori
- Gender
- Age
- (80% cases between 60-80)
- Peptic ulcer surgery
- Social deprivation (30%)


## Stage Specific Survival: Oesophageal Cancer



## Stage Specific Survival Gastric Cancer






