
Regional Cancer Networks in Scotland


NHS Board Areas in Scotland

This file contains the boundaries for NHS Board Areas in Scotland. The current boundaries are defined by National Health Service (Variation of Areas of Health Boards) (Scotland) Order 2013 (SSI 2013/347), which states that the extent of each board matches the combined areas of the Local Authorities that they serve.

There are 14 NHS Board Areas, which are responsible for healthcare provision in Scotland.

Cancer prevalence has been calculated for each NHS Board Area in Scotland, identifying the number of people living with cancer (and crude rate per 100,000) who were diagnosed between 1991 and 2010 for 21 different common cancer sites.






Local Authorities in Scotland

This file contains the boundaries for local authorities (also known as local council areas) in Scotland as at December 2011. Local authority districts is a generic term to describe the level of local government in Scotland.

There are 32 local authorities (or local council areas) in Scotland.
