

# Recording COVID ICD10 codes as part of routine cancer data collection through COSD

With the COVID-19 pandemic now affecting all aspects of NHS care, the following guidance has been drawn up to enable MDT coordinators to record the new COVID related ICD10 codes into the existing COSD dataset where applicable.

## Where COVID-19 is diagnosed alongside the primary cancer diagnosis (for example C50.9)

Please use the existing section [CORE - DIAGNOSIS - ADDITIONAL ITEMS], then input into CR7610 either:

- U07.1
- U07.2

These are the new emergency codes provided by WHO (<https://www.who.int/classifications/icd/covid19/en/>).

## Emergency use ICD codes for COVID-19 disease outbreak

The COVID-19 disease outbreak has been declared a public health emergency of international concern.

- An emergency ICD-10 code of 'U07.1 - COVID-19, virus identified' is assigned to a disease diagnosis of COVID-19 confirmed by laboratory testing.
- An emergency ICD-10 code of 'U07.2 - COVID-19, virus not identified' is assigned to a clinical or epidemiological diagnosis of COVID-19 where laboratory confirmation is inconclusive or not available.
